

The Crime Survey for England and Wales (CSEW) estimated that one in five adults aged 18 to 74 years experienced at least one form of child abuse, whether emotional abuse, physical abuse, sexual abuse, or witnessing domestic violence or abuse, before the age of 16 years (8.5 million people)











- I hate moving foster placement
- I have had such a bad experience
- I hate them for what they have done



- In the future you will be exceptional at... changing jobs/starting something new.
- You know, the experiences you have had will make you a strong adult
- I believe in forgiving people, not because they deserve forgiveness, but because we deserve inner peace




- I recognise that is hard for you, it will be ok


